Frequently asked questions

Does the nominee have to be local? A nominee needs to have a local presence. By local we mean regardless of their location, they represent a Richmond organization, and their impact is on this community.

How about a link to a web site? Sure. You can include a link to additional information if you want. It could prove useful if they have further questions or seek additional information.

How are the winners chosen? Finalists and winners are selected by MLM Award's Committee. The judges try to select finalists and winners that best represent the award category. All honorees are subject to a vetting process.
